### Degree program updates

#### **Bachelor of Business Administration**

**Status:** KU Edward's undergraduate advisor has started onsite advising at Johnson County Community College for this program.

#### **Bachelor of Science in Information Technology**

**Status:** KU Edward's undergraduate advisor has started onsite advising at Johnson County Community College for this program.

**Master of Engineering in Project Management, Master of Science in Project Management Status:** The School of Engineering officially named a new department for the campus – The Department of Engineering Management and Project Management. The advisory board for these new degrees will meet on October 24.

**Professional Science Masters in Applied Science (Concentration in Environmental Assessment)**

**Status:** The external advisory board for the Professional Science Master’s degree will meet on November 12 to provide continued input and guidance on this degree.

**Master of Science in Education - Educational Technology**

**Status:** The School of Education is conducting final interviews for faculty positions and for a shared advisor position with the undergraduate degree in exercise science. Planning is progressing for a MAC computer lab for this program. Marketing and recruiting efforts are underway.

**Bachelor of Science in Exercise Science**

**Status:** The curriculum has been finalized with Johnson County Community College and matches the new KU Core standards. Johnson County Community College has a transfer guide and is ready to advise students about the 2 + 2 program. The faculty program coordinator has been making visits to Johnson County Community College to promote this program. Development of the exercise lab has started. Marketing and recruiting efforts are underway.

**Bachelor of Applied Science - Biotechnology**

**Status:** After finalizing enrollment projections and funding in October, this proposal will go to the Board of Regents, possibly in November 2013. Anticipated approval for this degree is March 2014, with a launch date of fall 2014.

**Professional Science Masters in Applied Science (Concentration in Biotechnology)**

**Status:** The College of Liberal Arts and Sciences will begin work on this proposal in fall 2013.

**Bachelor of Science in Graphic Design**

**Status:** The design department is exploring new program directions and will begin work on a concept soon, potentially collaborating with other KU academic units. Anticipated launch spring 2015.

**JCERT Scholarship award summary**

**Johnson County Education & Research Triangle Scholarship** This grant is specifically for students who are enrolled in and admitted to an undergraduate or graduate program at the Edwards Campus that is funded by the Johnson County Education and Research Triangle tax. Requirements include residence in Johnson County, enrollment in a Triangle-funded program at the Edwards Campus, a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 and enrollment in a minimum of six hours at KU Edwards. Preference will be given to students with financial need. Completion of the FAFSA is required.
